



Do I have to attend any meetings on Wednesday?

Short answer – if you’re not on a committee or 1st Time Attendee - then NO! However, with the exception of the Nominating Committee Meetings, you’re welcome to sit-in on any Committee Meeting. This is a good opportunity to learn more about a specific committee and get “inside information” on what’s going on. All 1st Time Convention Attendees are encouraged to attend the Welcome Meeting at 4:00pm on Wednesday. An overview about the Convention will take place along with a chance to meet other “newbies” and ask questions.

Who can attend the Foundation Meeting on Thursday?

All members of UNICO can attend the meeting of the

Foundation Trustees.

Is it important that I attend the General Sessions?

Uh, yes – that’s why you’re here! Especially if you’re a Chapter Officer or Delegate – you should be there to hear what’s being discussed and scheduled to be voted upon.

What’s this District Governor Meeting/Voting at 8:00am on Friday?

This is the meeting where the voting for the Regional District Governors takes place. All Incoming District Governors, District Governors or Past District Governors should attend.

Who gets to vote on Friday?

In compliance with our constitution, voting by eligible UNICO members must take place from 9am – 11am on the Friday of our National Convention. Ballots will be cast for National Officers and for proposed Amendments to the Constitution. If you received a voting slip at registration – it is IMPERATIVE that you vote at this time.

So I attended the General Sessions and voted as required, do I have to stick around for the Board of Directors meeting on Saturday?

You don’t have to, but you should. It’s open to all UNICO members and this first meeting really sets the tone for the upcoming year. Appointments to the Executive Committee take place along with other required business presented to the Board of Directors.

Sounds like a lot of meetings, do I ever get a break?

We do our best to keep all meetings on schedule and on topic. It’s our National Convention and we have lots of business to discuss. This is our time to receive updates on what’s happened over the year and to bring to the Members issues, concerns, successes, etc. And along with that, we try to leave time for fun! You’ll have most afternoons and evenings free.
